MES PUBLIC SCHOOL, P.Vemballur started this academic year for grades 1-12 on 2nd June 2021. Opening ceremony was organized online through Google platform. An awareness class was arranged for parents on the topic –“Improving Mental Strength” by the renowned psychologist Mrs.Nishi Salam Classes started online for montessori seniors on June 7 and for Montessori juniors on June 10 .It was inaugurated by our most respected treasurer MES State Committee-Mr.K.K.Kunju Moideen.

World Environment Day was celebrated on June 5<sup>th</sup> of June .Our students planted saplings in their surroundings. Speech ,Collage and Video making competitions were held to spread awareness among students about the need to protect the environment and the ways to do it. .Reading Day, Anti Narcotic Day and Independence day was also celebrated with various events.

- Offline and online meetings were held with management, teachers and parents and an online survey was conducted to collect their valuable feedback regarding the reopening of school, the areas to look out for and about the activities that can boost the mental and emotional wellbeing of the students.
- Regular staff meetings helped the teachers to build more self-confidence .Our committed staff of teachers are undergoing a process of continuous development by undertaking a number of training sessions on different portals. - To help children to improve upon their communication skill, We started foundation course in English Grammar for grade 6 and 7 under the initiative of our English tutor Mr Siyad. We have arranged special course completion certificates for them.
- For the perfect functioning of school, we organised various committees for examinations, counseling, curricular and co-curricular activities, time table, health monitoring, trainings etc.
